**REQUESTING THE LGUs TO INSTITUTIONALIZE THE COMMUNITY BASED
DIALOGUE IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS TO ADDRESS HUMAN
RIGHTS CONCERNS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR**

WHEREAS, the Community-Based Dialogue (CBD) Sessions on Human Rights Promotion and Protection between the Commission on Human Rights (CHR), Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and the Philippine National Police (PNP), and Civil Society Organizations and Local Communities, with the Hanns Seidel Foundation of Germany was launched in 2008, with the overall objective of improving the Human Rights situation in the Philippines primarily through the enhancement of the relationship between the AFP and PNP, on one hand, and local communities and civil society organizations, on the other hand;

WHEREAS, the CBD-CAR Core Group as convened by the Commission on Human Rights (CHR-CAR) conducted series of CBDs on issues affecting political, civil, economic, social, and cultural rights in the Cordillera Administrative Region from 2018-2020;

WHEREAS, the CBDs were proven to be an effective tool in soliciting community cooperation and participation in the region where the concept of community dialogue and cooperation is ingrained in indigenous practices like "Tongtongan";

WHEREAS, community based dialogue provides for direct community participation as an integral part of democratic governance and is an acknowledged tool in the promotion of human rights;

WHEREAS, the local government units (LGUs) play significant role in the success of CBDs because of their knowledge and influence in their respective communities;

WHEREAS, the institutionalization of the Community Based Dialogues through the enactment of local ordinance is needed to sustain community cooperation and participation in the promotion of human rights at the local level;

WHEREAS, the existing Human Rights Action Teams (HRAcTs) mandated under the DILG-CHR Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01 S. 2014 (*Mainstreaming Human Rights at the Level of Provinces, Cities/Municipalities and Barangays*) may serve as focal of the localized CBD;

WHEREAS, the RDC-CAR Sectoral Committee on Development Administration and Good Governance in its 4th Quarter Meeting on November 11, 2021 approved the resolution ""Resolution Requesting the Institutionalization of the Community Based Dialogue in the

The round metal gong of the Cordillera known locally as "gangsa" is a symbol of the upland people's culture that has been passed on from generations to another. The profile of a person blowing a "tangguyob" represents a community being called for an important matter or action. The lines that shape the mountains, the rice terraces, clouds and rivers symbolize the connectivity and flow of human interaction in a geographic area such as the Cordillera. All the symbols combined represent unity and harmony of the people with culture and environment in beating the gong for self-determination.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copy of this resolution be furnished to the CHR-CAR, DILG-CAR and to the local government units thru the city/ provincial governments for information and appropriate action.

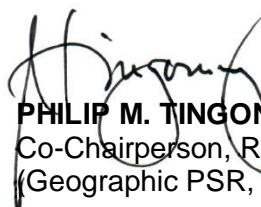

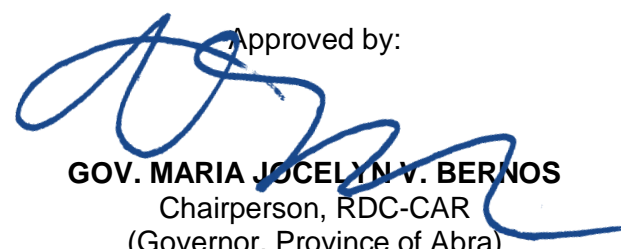
